- 16 **RESOLVED,** that the 2019 Eastern Washington-Idaho Synod Assembly receive the
- 17 congregation of New Day Lutheran Church, located in Idaho Falls, Idaho and a part of the
- 18 Upper Snake River Cluster, as a member congregation of the Synod, with all the rights and
- 19 responsibilities thereof; and be it further
